Sunday Services

10:45am - Morning Service

We start with a time of worship, take communion and then have a sermon from one of our preachers (and sometimes a visiting guest speaker). People are welcome to stay around afterwards for tea, coffee and a good chat too!

We also have “kid’s church” and the “Mouteens” group (for teenagers) during the sermon.

8:00am - Teaching & Worship videos

Using video resources, we share a time of worship and benefit from the ministry of speakers from various ministries around the world. We are currently following a series of talks by David Sliker on biblical eschatology delivered to students at IHOP International House of Prayer) University in Kansas City.

Mission Focus

Sunday afternoons, once quarterly

We support full time missionaries in France, India, Zimbabwe and the UK while many of our members undertake short term mission work. Mission Focus is a platform for our community to learn about what God is doing in the world.

IHOP Prayer Room Stream

Monday, Tuesday and Friday. 1:30pm – 3pm

We stream the prayer room from IHOP (International House of Prayer) in Kansas City, every Monday, Tuesday and Friday. This is a great time to come and spend with God, to take some time out of your day to minister to God through worship, intercession and meditating on the Bible.

Mums and Toddlers

Tuesdays and Thursdays, 9.45am – 11.00am

During term times we run a group for families and their pre-school age children. All are welcome from the local community to come and let their children play, plus meet other mums from the area.

CALL

Wednesdays, 2.00pm

CALL is a local charity providing emotional support for those living with cancer alongside those closest to them, friends, family and carers. The group meet in Mount Chapel on Wednesday afternoons.

We lead an afternoon service of singing and reflection at a local residential care home for the elderly.

Home Groups

Wednesday and Thursday evenings

Each week we meet in small home groups to study the Bible, encourage, support, pray and enjoy each other's company. There is always space in groups for new members and we recommend this as a way of getting to know people in the fellowship.

Boaz Night Shelter

Thursdays, November to April

We work with the Boaz Trust to provide a weekly night shelter for the homeless and destitute. Throughout the harshest months of the year we open up the Church as a place of refuge and give those who have nothing a place to sleep and some decent food to eat.

Friday Night Prayer

Friday evenings

This is our main prayer meeting. Friday night prayer runs weekly, and is a great place to come to seek God's face, to pray for the life of the church and to pray for His kingdom to come in our lives and in our city.





Deborah Arise

Saturday Mornings

Deborah Arise is an initiative started to encourage women to pray for young people to become passionate about Jesus and share this passion with their peers. Women meet weekly in pairs and the whole group meets every few months for prayer, praise and encouragement.

Alpha Course

As announced (we are not currently running a course but we usually run one if there is demand)

We run our own versions of the successful Alpha course to help individuals discover more about the Christian faith for themselves, at their own pace in a non-threatening environment.

Weekend Away

Annually

Once a year the church goes on a weekend away to seek God together and grow as a fellowship. We invite a guest speaker and meet together at a retreat centre. We worship, play sports, relax, drink tea and eat well!

Weekend At Home

Annually

Our weekends at home are like the weekends away, but not away. We have a time of fellowship at church with worship, teaching and fun activities. This is normally a full day on Saturday plus an extended Sunday programme.

Prayer Chain

Whenever needed

We have a prayer chain of individuals and families who are committed to praying at short notice for emergency situations. When people have a matter for the prayer, they let us know so we can inform others and pray with them from wherever we are.
