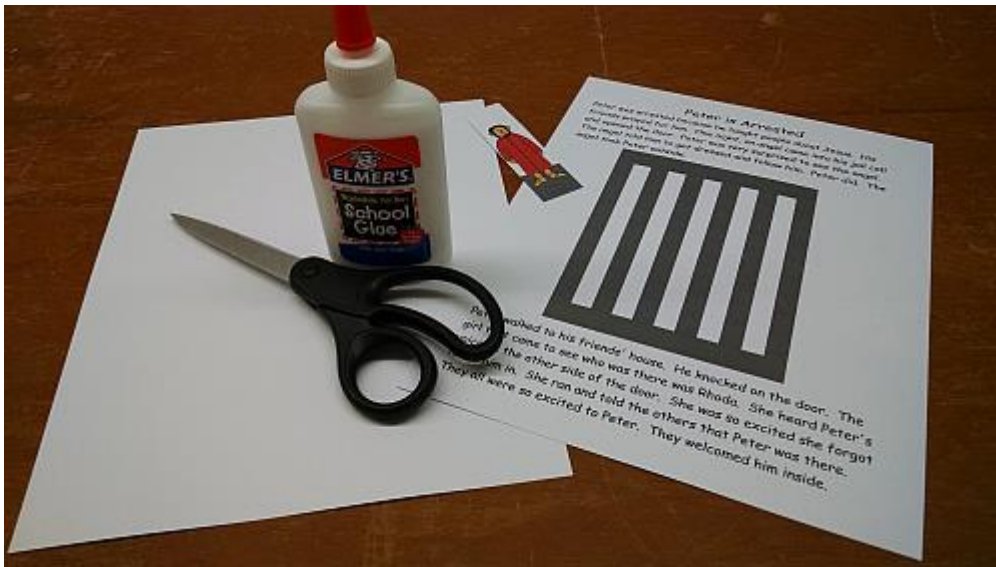


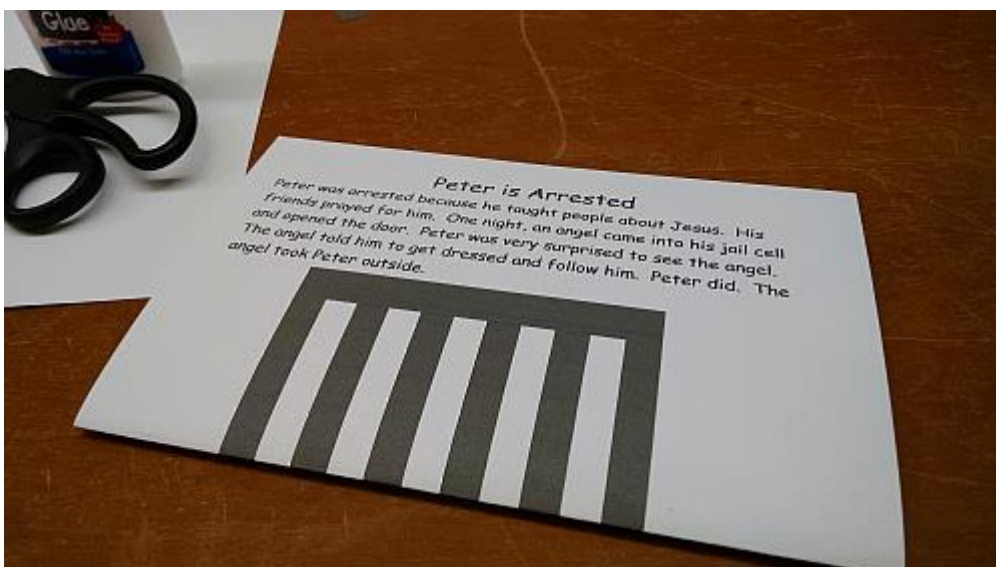
Instructions for the Peter in Jail craft 😊 (The ones on the PDF are a bit hard to follow so I found these!)

You will need: PDF Printed, Scissors and Glue.

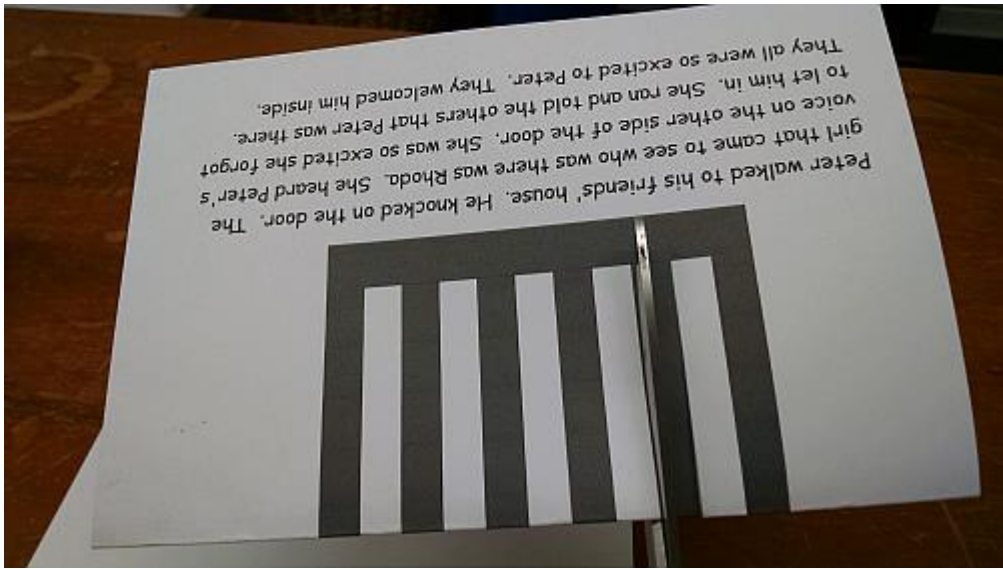
Print out the PDF on paper, which includes more Peters than one person will need and get yourself another piece of A4 card. This can be coloured if you like and will provide the jail background.



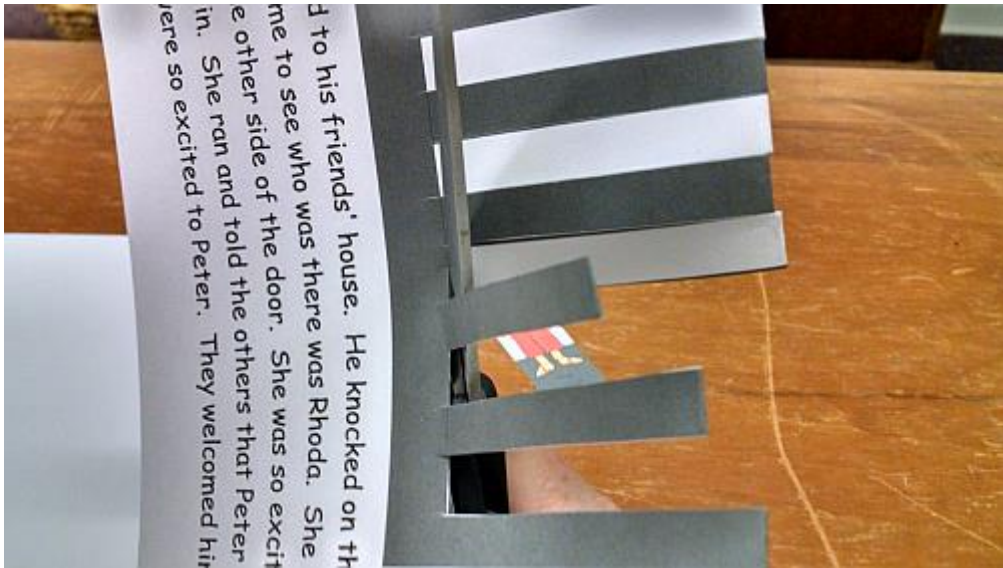
Fold the printed page in half as shown below.



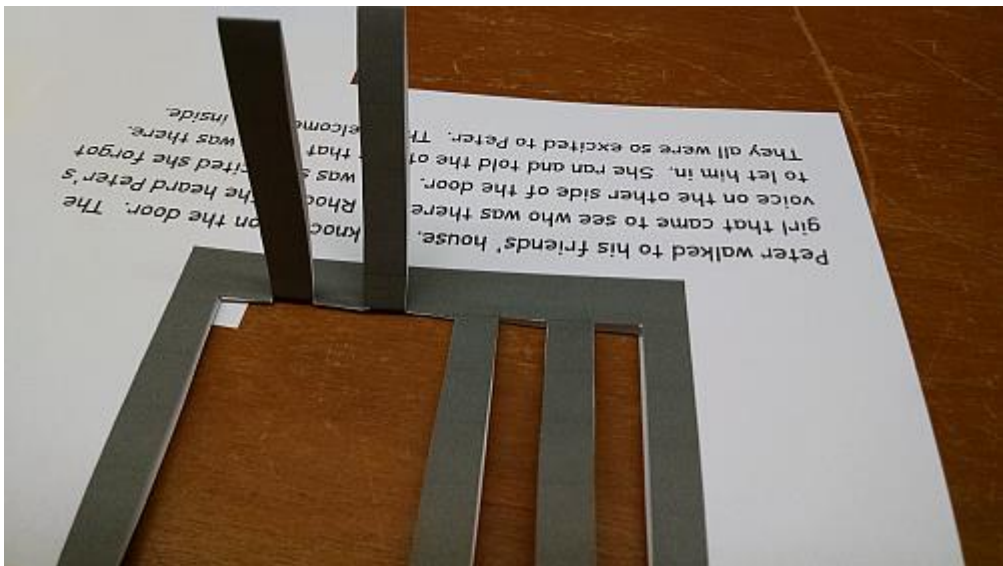
Cut along the black bars of the jail. You don't have to cut the outer lines, but if you do it still works fine.



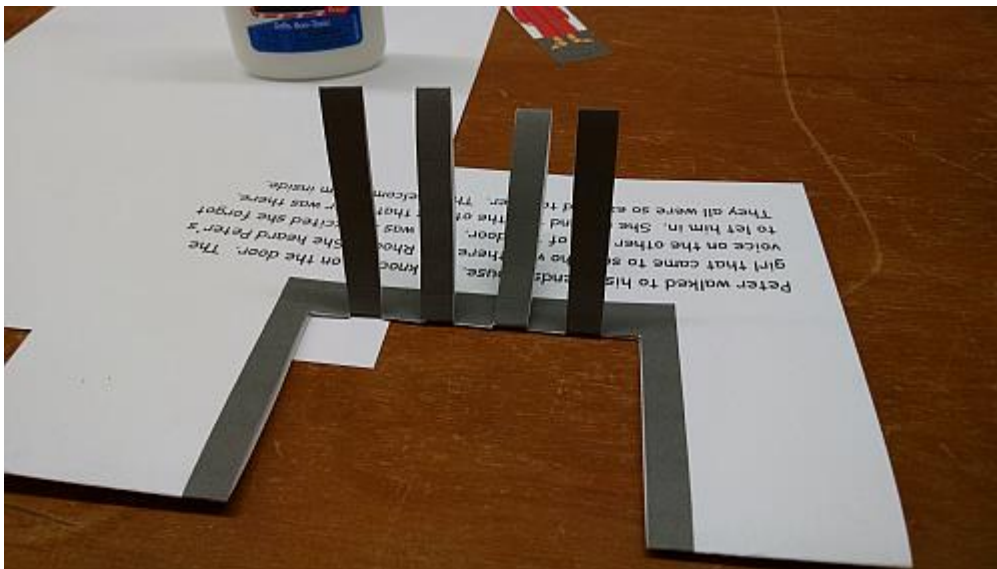
Cut the white strips of paper off.



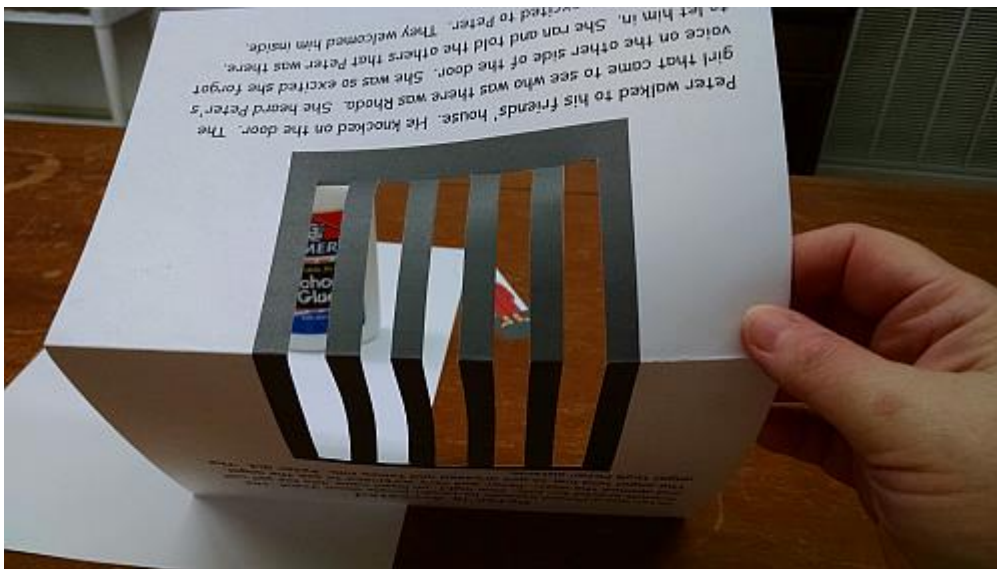
Fold each of the jail bars at the bottom.



So far, it should look like this:



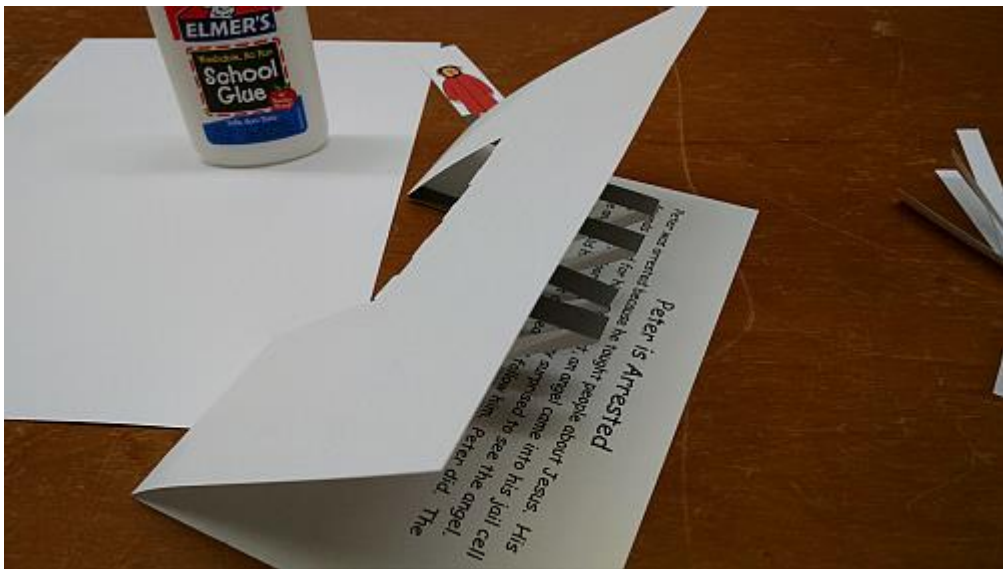
Open up the page and you will begin to see the jail taking shape.



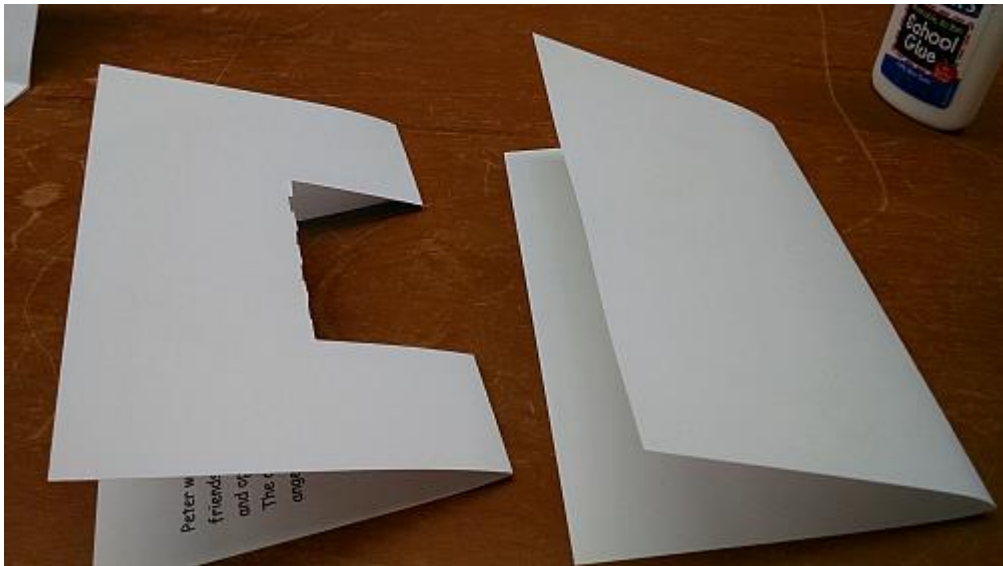
Push the paper back but keep the jail bars folded forward.



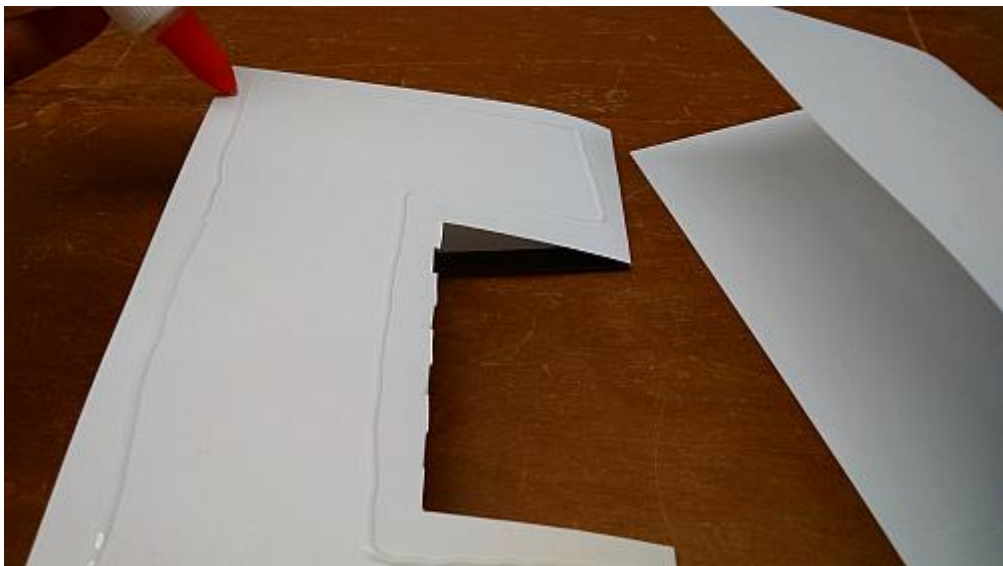
Fold page in half with the printed side on the inside.



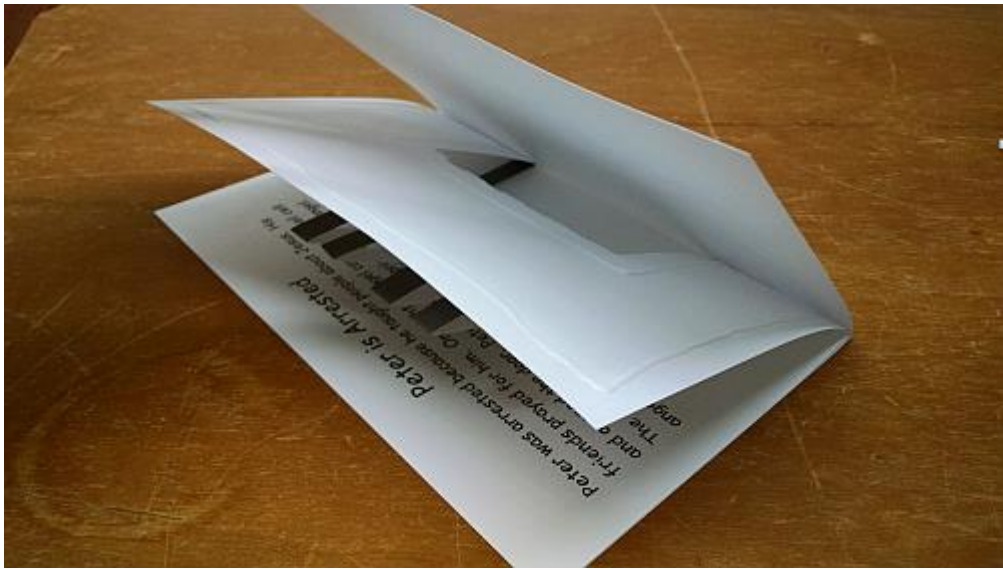
Now take the piece of card and fold it in half horizontally.



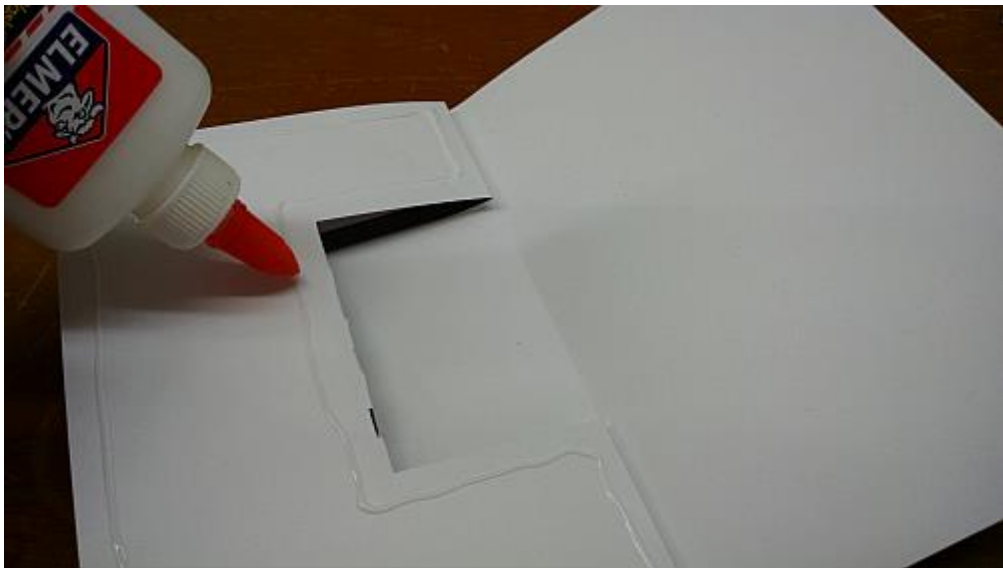
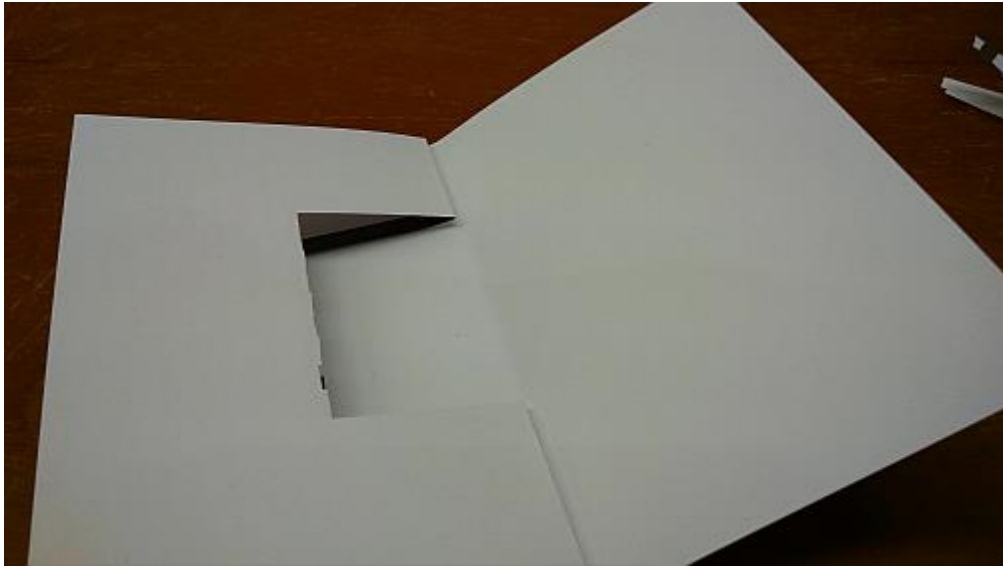
Put thin line of glue along ALL edges of the jail page.



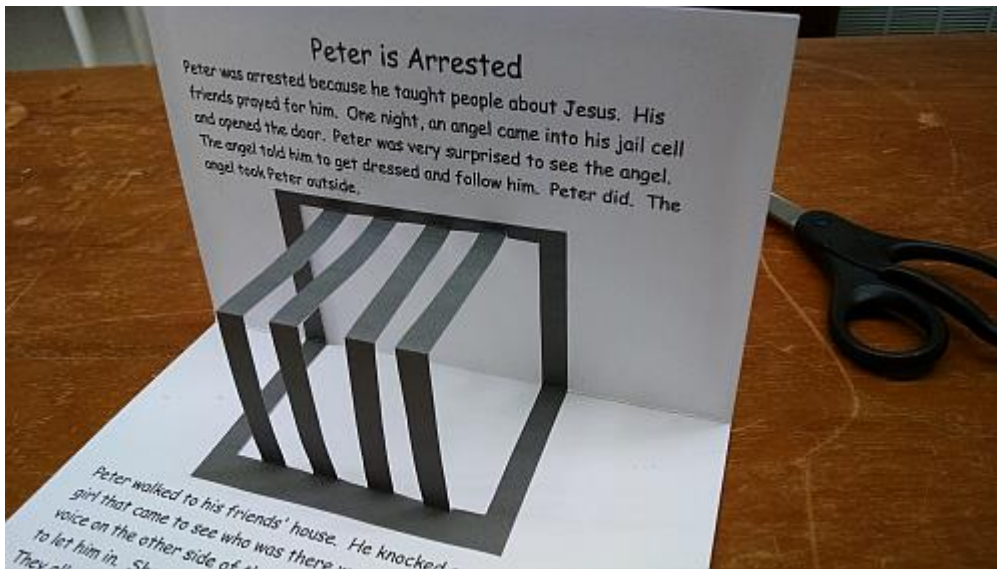
Put this page inside the folded card and press down.



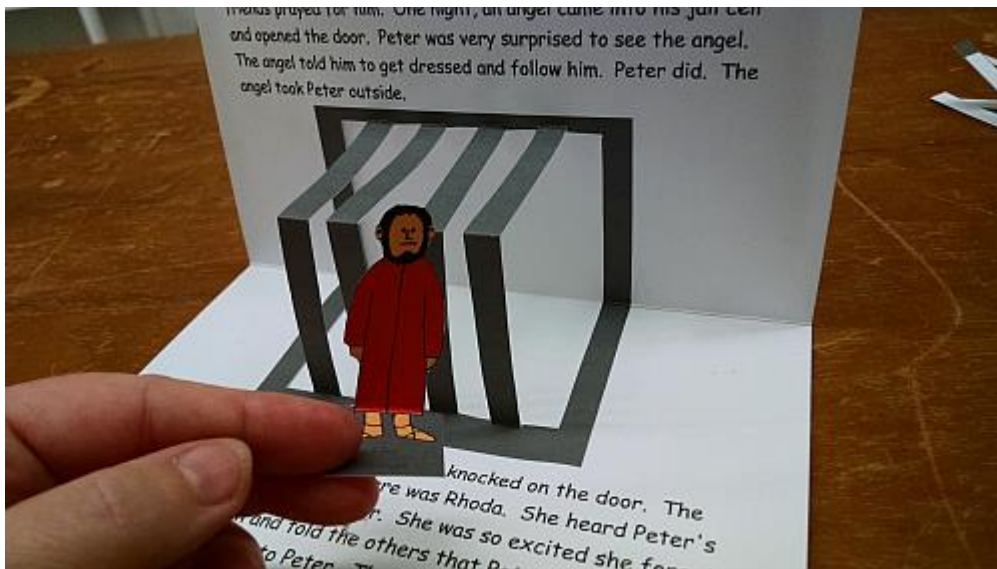
Flip the page over and repeat on the other side.



Open the page and you now have a little jail.



Cut out a Peter figure.



Fold the grey square to make the stand and apply glue to the bottom. Place him in the jail. That's all there is to it.
