

"You Won't Bee-lieve This"

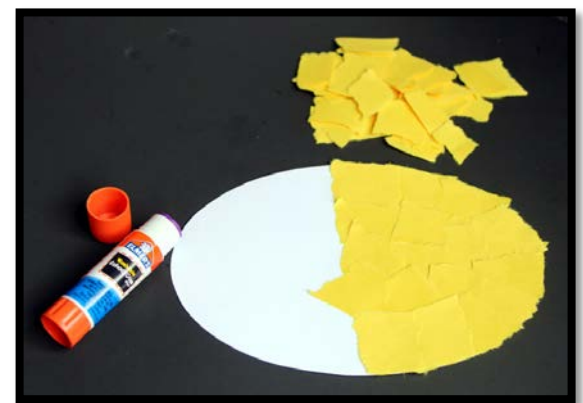


» Materials

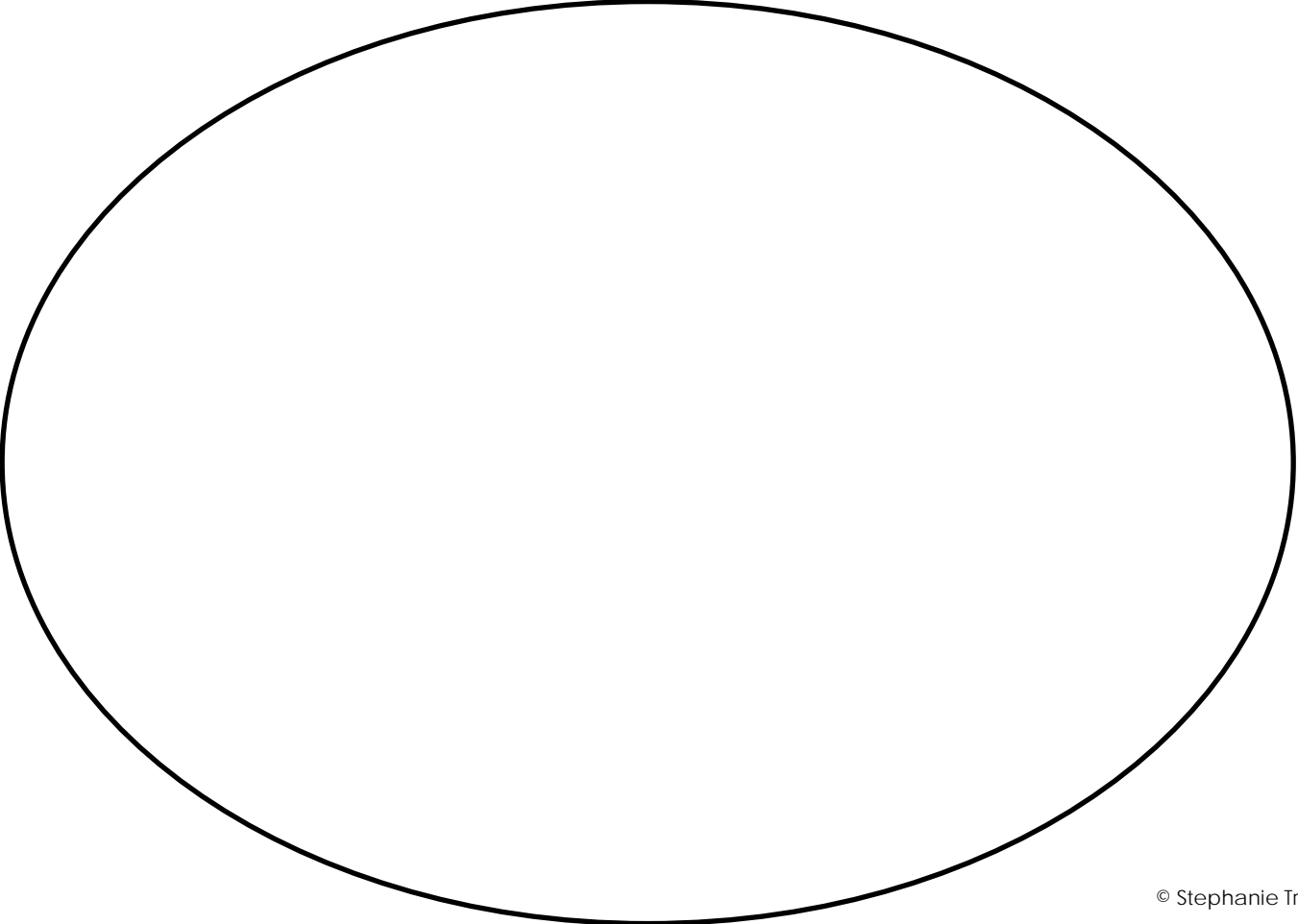
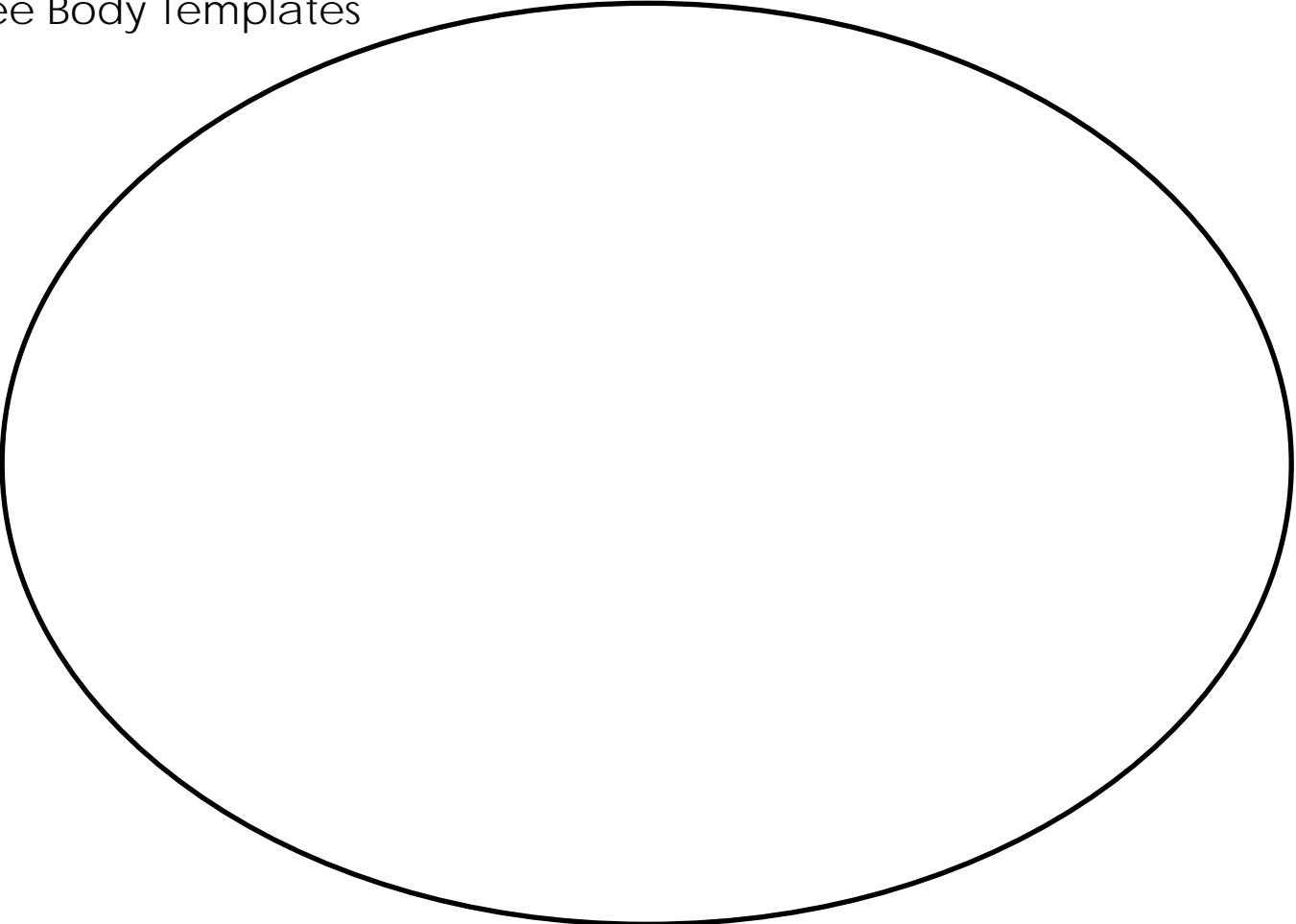
- Bee body templates
- yellow and black construction paper
- black pipe cleaners (2 per bee)
- paper towels
- clear tape
- stick glue

» Directions

1. Print and cut out all of the bee body templates.
2. Tear the yellow construction paper into small 1 to 2 inch square pieces. Glue the yellow squares onto the bee body and head templates, overlapping the squares to completely cover the templates.
3. Tear the black construction paper into 1 inch wide strips to make the bee's stripes. Glue the stripes on and tear off the excess strips at the edges.
4. Cut a small black triangle out of the construction paper and glue on for the stinger.
5. Glue the eyes onto the head. Draw on a wide smile and then glue the head onto the body.
6. Tape the black pipe cleaners onto the back of the head in the center above the eyes.
7. Lay the wing template onto a paper towel. Trace the template and cut it out. Glue or tape the paper towel wing onto the template to create a textured wing. (Be sure to use glue that dries clear or it will show through the paper towel.) Glue the wing onto the body.
